COVID-19 infections are increasing in United Arab Emirates, with 17635 new infections reported on average each day. The total number of cases in UAE as on June 30 are 945,800, while total recoveries stand at 925,849. The death toll now stands at 2,316 – as of 3rd July 2022 . The United Arab Emirates has administered at least 24,922,054 doses of COVID vaccines so far. Assuming every person needs 2 doses, that’s enough to have vaccinated about 127.5% of the country’s population. Over 169.7 million PCR tests have been conducted in the country so far. Doctors in the UAE have urged patients recovering from severe COVID-19 conditions to rest at least a couple of weeks before they can go back to work. Most patients can return to normal work and life after 10-14 days. Those with mild symptoms do not need to alter their routine and lifestyle significantly. Also, please follow health protocols as the authorities have announced that wearing a facemask is mandatory in closed and indoor places to curb the spread of COVID-19 in the country.

Building Fit-Out Guideline

Hazardous Substances to Health

4.7.1. The Fit-out Contractors should control exposure to hazardous substances to prevent ill health. Contractors have to protect both employees and others who may be exposed, by complying with the Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations. The Fit-out Contractors should assess risks, implement measures needed to control exposure and establish good working practices.



4.7.2 Risk to health from hazardous substances used should be assessed properly and adequate measures implemented to prevent or control employees being exposed to hazardous substances.
